AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court for issuance of a direction, especially in the nature of mandamus directing the Deputy Commissioner, Sangrur-respondent No.2 to consider the claim of the petitioner, as has been projected in his legal notice dated 07.05.2018 (Annexure P-1), wherein a prayer has been made for fixation of wards and publication of the schedule regarding reservation of the post of Sarpanch in Block Bhawanigarh.

2. Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Deputy Commissioner, Sangrur, to consider the legal notice dated 07.05.2018 (Annexure P-1) served upon the said respondent, within some specified time and pass appropriate orders thereon.

3. In the light of the prayer made by the counsel for the petitioner, without going into merits thereof or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Deputy Commissioner, Sangrur, to consider the legal notice dated 07.05.2018 (Annexure P-1) and decide the same within a period of six weeks from today. Decision so taken

be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
