The grievance of the petitioner is that he is entitled to grant of employment in terms of policy dated 14.02.2012 (Annexure P-4), on account of acquisition of his land for the Rajiv Gandhi Thermal Power Plant, Khedar, District Hisar. Numerous representations have been made but the respondents have failed to grant him employment.
