The Director, Local Audit Department called for Expression of Interest (EOI) from various Chartered Accountants to conduct the audit of various Gram Panchayats' accounts in the State of Haryana. The short-term tenders were considered and pursuant thereto, the work orders have since been issued to private-respondent Nos.5 to 13 on 25.04.2018. At this belated juncture when the respondents have changed their position and taken-over the assigned work, the petitioner cannot be permitted to question the very decision of calling EOI. However, it shall not preclude the petitioner to challenge such notice as and when issued in future. In case the allotted work is extended for unreasonable period, the petitioner may re-agitate the matter in accordance with law.

The writ petition stands disposed of in above terms.
