The petitioners are working as Head Constables in the Haryana Police. For promotion to the post of Assistant Sub Inspector, they are required to pass departmental examination of Intermediate School Course. Respondent No.4 had asked for additional seats vide letter dated 26.03.2018 (Annexure P-2) on the ground that the seniors had been left out from the course commencing w.e.f. 21.05.2018. Thereafter, respondent No.3 recommended the case to respondent No.2 vide letter dated 06.04.2018 (Annexure P-5). Meanwhile, the medical examination of the petitioners was also conducted and they were found fit. The course has commenced, but no action has been taken by respondent No.2 upon the recommendation (Annexure P-5)

Notice of motion.

Mr. Gaurav Jindal, Addl., AG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State of Haryana. Let five copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to seek written statement, at this stage.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to consider the recommendation (Annexure P-5) and pass a speaking order thereupon, within a period of seven days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case the recommendation is accepted, the petitioners be permitted to join the course, which is started w.e.f. 21.05.2018 subject however, to any limitation that might exist regarding attendance.
