This order shall dispose of two writ petitions bearing CWP No.13731 of 2018 – Pratibha Jha and others v. State of Haryana and others and CWP No.13943 of 2018 – Puran Chand and others v. State of Haryana and others and

Learned counsel for the respondents have stated that they would make every endeavour to resolve the issue d'hors the merits of the case and keeping in view the urgency of utilising the land for a project of national importance.

Written statement on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3 has also been filed in the Court. It is stated that possession of the plots to the persons, who were signatories to the FTS would be handed over within a

period of one week commencing today. The petitioners shall present all the affected persons who are party to the FTS and entitled to a plot, for verification, at 10:00 A.M on Thursday i.e. 31.05.2018 before the Administrator, HUDA, Gurgaon whereafter the process of handing over the possession shall be completed as indicated above. It is made clear that no excuse from either of the parties shall be brooked on the plea that they were not in the know of the order or any other pretext that they may choose to raise to defeat the orders of the Court or the process of handing over the possession. We make it clear that this will be the last opportunity to these affected persons, to accept the offer of possession in terms of the settlement to which they bound themselves. We also make it clear that any attempt of the petitioners to resist eviction shall be viewed by this Court as an obstruction to the course of justice and dealt with properly. The petitioners would submit themselves to the orders of this Court as also to the process of law peacefully and any attempt to brow-beat the process of law will also be dealt with appropriately.

The possession of the vacant premises shall be voluntarily handed over by the petitioners to the respondents within a week after taking the possession.

Both petitions are disposed of in above terms.
