The petitioner is the Electricity Ombudsman. A decision dated 22.03.2018 has been taken by the Commission by majority that the petitioner is not bound to mark his attendance in the Aadhar based Biometric Attendance System. The present writ petition has been filed with a grievance that although, the decision of the Commission is in favour of the petitioner, but his name is not being removed from the said Biometric Attendance System.

The grievance is meritless. Once, the Commission has taken a decision that the petitioner is not bound to mark his attendance through the aforementioned Biometric Attendance System, no further directions are called for. In any case, the High Court is not an executing authority of the Electricity Regulatory Commission.

In view of the above, the writ petition is dismissed.
