The instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought the issuance of a writ particularly in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to remove the anomaly between senior and junior ETT teachers, which has occurred due to the shifting of ETT teachers of Zila Parishad and Municipal Corporation/Municipal Council with the Education Department and also give direction to the respondents for stepping up the pay of senior teachers as per the Government Instructions (Annexure P-3) thereby removing the anomaly as equal to the junior teachers, thereby removing the anomaly.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that though representation dated 05.05.2018 (P-7) moved to the respondents but till date no final decision has been taken by the concerned authority. He further submits that they feel satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide the aforesaid representation dated 05.05.2018 (P-7) within stipulated

period.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to consider and decide the representation dated 05.05.2018 (Annexure P-7) as per rules, regulations and instructions issued by the Government from time to time, within a period of three months would start from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order in terms of CWP No. 17640 of 2015 & CWP No. 8884 of 2016 (P-10 & P-11, respectively).

4. However, if petitioners still feel aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, they shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies available under law as well as to approach this Court.
