Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release him the salary/pay for the period of 01.07.2016 to 04.08.2016 on account of prolonged stay in abroad on medical grounds along-with interest @12% per annum from the due date till its actual realization.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that petitioner served a legal notice dated 16.01.2018 (P-8) upon the respondents to release his pay/salary for the period of 01.07.2016 to 04.08.2016 but till date no action has been taken. He further submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to consider and decide the afore said legal notice (P-8) within a stipulated period.

3. Without expressing any opinion on merit as well as afore-said submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents particularly to respondent No.2 to consider the cases of the petitioner as set out in the legal notice dated 16.01.2018 (P-8) and to take a conscious decision in accordance with law, rules and regulations, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available under law including to approach this Court.
