States that he belongs to Scheduled Caste community and according to the prevailing scheme he is entitled to be awarded the ownership right of the Shamlat Land where he has constructed his house and in this regard he has made various representations.

Consequently, without commenting on the controversy or the previous litigation pending inter se between the petitioner and the Gram Panchayat, we deem it appropriate to direct the competent authority to look into the grievance of the petitioner expressed in the representations and decide the same as expeditiously as possible. The appeal filed by the petitioner be also disposed of expeditiously. Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands disposed of.
