ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral)

The petitioner is employed as Multi Purpose Health Supervisor (Male) with the respondent-department. He is aggrieved by his transfer from PHC Paksma CHC Kilo Rohtak to the Office of Civil Surgeon Faridabad caused by an order dated 14.07.2017 (Annexure P3) vice respondent No.6. Ex facie, the impugned order was passed over 9 months ago. And, for no interim order was granted by this Court, in compliance thereof, the petitioner had since jointed at his new place of posting. In a nutshell, the grievance of the petitioner is; that his transfer is in breach of the transfer policy of the State, and was affected only to adjust respondent No.6, who in any case had served in District Rohtak for over 15 years.

Having argued the matter at some length, learned counsel for the parties have reached a consensus; that let this petition be disposed of only with a direction to official respondents to re-visit the issue, as also the

claim/grievance of the petitioner, and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law.

The petition is accordingly disposed of in the above terms.

The respondent-authorities shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof, within a period of eight weeks from today. Needless to assert that this order shall not constitute any expression of opinion on merits of the case of either party, for the authorities shall be free to arrive at an appropriate decision in the matter.
