By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the gratuity, TA bill amounting to ₹17800/- and amount of ₹37000/- against bill for the purchase of insulators of L.T. along-with interest.

2. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that petitioner stood retired on 31.03.2016 on attaining the age of superannuation but till date the amount accrued to the petitioner on account of gratuity as well as amount of TA bill amounting to ₹17800/- including price of 200 insulators amounting to ₹37000/- have not been paid to him. Petitioner constrained to serve legal notice dated 13.12.2017 (P-2) upon the respondents but till date

neither any response to the notice has been received nor any action has been taken. At this juncture, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to consider and decide the afore-said legal notice within a time bound manner.

3. Without expressing any opinion on merit but considering the afore-said aspects, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 13.12. 2017 (P-2) and to take a conscious decision in accordance with law, rules and regulations, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available under law including to approach this Court.
