Mr.Vijay Singh Dahiya, IAS Director General Higher Education, Haryana is present in Court today and has filed reply. The same is taken on record.

The reply explains that the names of the petitioners were not mentioned in the order dated 16.08.2014 at the time of taking over the self-financing college, P.K. S. D. College, Kanina, District Mohindergarh by the Government as per the surplus right-sizing policy. The issue has arisen when the Government took over the college. On reconsideration of the matter, the petitioners have been accepted and conferred status as government servants together with other staff and employees of the private college whose assets and liabilities have been taken over by the State Government and their services have been made regular. The terms and conditions mentioned in the order dated

02.02.2016 will govern relationship. Their monetary dues have been calculated retrospectively and paid to the petitioners as per Annexure 'F'/receipts paying arrears of 15 months salary.

It may be recorded that other than the order dated 02.02.2016 the revised appointment letter dated 27.12.2017 has also been placed on record containing terms and conditions of service binding on both the parties. This resolves the dispute and nothing remains to be determined by this Court since relief has been granted.

The petition is disposed of as infructuous.

In case the petitioners have any subsisting grievance they may approach the department for resolution. If they still feel aggrieved, they are always at liberty to approach this Court, if advised.
