Learned State Counsel has produced a memo No. 26/76-2016 C-IV (2) dated 11.01.2018 in Court today written by the Director General Higher Education, Haryana, Panchkula to the Advocate General Haryana, Chandigarh containing a decision in paragraph No.2 that the claim of the petitioners has been considered by the competent authority in the light of the judgment of this Court in Tejvir & others Vs. State of Haryana & others; 2008 (4) SCT 469 and the same is liable to be accepted. The individual cases of the petitioners have already been invited by the Department from the concerned Principals of the colleges where they teach. After receipt of the complete record from the Principals concerned, the benefit of the senior/selection grade will be awarded to the eligible candidates.

With this dispensation, no issue is left to be decided by this Court. The same is also covered by the decision already taken by the Government. As a result, the petition is disposed of with the direction to the respondent to conclude the exercise within four months and thereafter within a reasonable time pass on the monetary benefits to the eligible candidates in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of.
