ARUN MONGA, J (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the respondents contends that the case of the petitioner is totally covered by Annexure R-3/1 which is a judgment rendered by this Court in CWP No.1964 of 2014, decided on 03.02.2014 and the said contention of the respondents is not objected to by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view thereof, the petitioner is directed to approach the civil Courts within a period of four weeks in the same terms as recorded in CWP No.1964 of 2014, decided on 03.02.2014. The relevant para thereof is extracted hereinbelow;-

“Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to approach the Civil Courts for redressal of their grievances, wherein they have full opportunity to lead evidence. It is hoped that in case the said civil suits are filed within four months from today, the learned trial Court would endeavour to dispose of the said suits as expeditiously as possible keeping in view the nature of the dispute involved”.

In view thereof the present writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the Civil Courts as above.
