The petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India challenging the transfer order dated 17.05.2017 (Annexure P-2) within the same district. Admittedly, the place of transfer is only 65 kilometers away. The petitioner has also been departmentally proceeded against. The only ground is that his wife is also working on a Government job in the same village and it is a couple case.

In view of the fact that departmental proceedings are carrying on, the administrative action on behalf of the respondents for transfer has apparently been taken.

In these circumstances, this Court does not find any ground to interfere against the order of transfer.

Resultantly, the present writ petition is dismissed as it is settled principle that writ petition Court does not normally interfere in the cases of transfer.
