Petitioner-Lakhwinder Kaur preferred instant civil writ petition, under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of a writ particularly in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to pass a speaking order on the legal notices/representations as submitted by the petitioner dated 02.09.2016 (Annexure P-3), 20.08.2016 (Annexure P-2) and 15.09.2011 (Annexure P-1)

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though representations/legal notices including latest legal notice dated 20.08.2016 (P-2) moved to the respondents but till date no final decision has been taken by the concerned authority. He further submits that she feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide the aforesaid latest legal notice (P-2) within stipulated period.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to

consider the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 20.08.2016 (P-2) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order as per rules, regulations and instructions issued by the Government from time to time, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, she shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies available under law as well as to approach this Court.
