AJAY KUMAR MITTAL, ACJ.

1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of direction to the respondents to acquire the land of the petitioners and to pay compensation. Further prayer is also made that if the State Government is not interested to acquire the said land, necessary amendment for excluding the land of Village Kaimbwala from the map of catchment area of Sukhna Lake may be passed.

2. After arguing for sometime when the Bench was not inclined to accept the prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner on the ground that the petitioner has no *locus standi* to file the present writ petition, learned senior counsel prayed that she may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn as prayed.
