The petitioner is working as a Math Master in Government High School in Munak Kalan, Block Tanda-II, District Hoshiarpur. He has made various representations to the respondents for counting his service rendered in a Privately Managed Aided School for the purposes of grant of pensionary benefits. The representations were not heeded and thereafter, legal notice dated 30.04.2018 (Annexure P-3) has been served in this regard but no action has been taken thereupon till date.
