The petitioners are working on Class-IV posts of Peon/Mali in the Education Department of the State of Haryana. Their grievance is that their services should have been regularised with effect from the date same benefit was granted to the juniors. A legal notice dated 16.02.2018 (Annexure P-7) has been issued in this regard but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3.

Mr. Gaurav Jindal, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Let four copies of the complete paperbook be supplied to him during the course of the day. In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to seek written statement or issue notice to respondent No.4.

The writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3, to objectively consider the legal notice dated 16.02.2018 (Annexure P-7), within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
