This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant the benefit of 23 year advance promotional increments w.e.f. 24.12.2009 as per the principal policy under Finance Circulars 17/1990 dated 23.04.1990 amended from time to time & Clarificatory Circular/Letter dated 26.02.2007 issued by Government of Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Senior Executive Engineer, PSPCL DS Division City Sunam, District Sangrur to consider and decide the legal notice dated 27.04.2018 (Annexure P-6).

Heard.

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-

Senior Executive Engineer, PSPCL DS Division City Sunam, District Sangrur to consider and decide the legal notice dated 27.04.2018 (Annexure P-6) within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible to him or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
