The instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ particularly in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to consider and promote the petitioner over and above his junior-respondent No.5 as Clerk or Patwari in view of the Rules, instructions and the law laid down by this Hon'ble Court with all consequential benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though representation dated Nil (P-10) moved to the respondents but till date no final decision has been taken by the concerned authority. He further submits that they feel satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide the aforesaid representation dated Nil (P-10) within stipulated period.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to consider and decide the representation dated Nil (P-10) as per rules, regulations and

instructions issued by the Government from time to time, within a period of four months which would start from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The petition stands disposed of as above.
