The dispute in the present writ petition is with regard to pension and retiral benefits. Petitioner is claiming the pension as well as retiral benefits from the respondent No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioner informs that during pendency of the petition, certain retiral benefits have been allowed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that Accountant General, Punjab, vide order dated 12.09.2018 has already passed an order for the release of the pensionary benefits including the pension. The said order has been supplied to the State counsel as well.

Counsel for the petitioner states that no further order is required except for directing the respondents to implement the said order within a given time frame.

Let respondent No.5 implement the order passed by the Accountant General, Punjab dated 12.09.2018 fixing the retiral benefits as well as pension in case of petitioner Nirmal Singh. Let the payment in

respect of order passed by the Accountant General, Punjab dated 12.09.2018
be made to the petitioner within a period of three months.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
