This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to promote the petitioner from the post of Medical Laboratory Technician Grade-I to the post of Senior Medical Laboratory Technician in the office of the Civil Surgeon, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2- Director, Department of Health & Family Welfare, Sector-34, Chandigarh to consider and decide the representation dated 14.02.2013 (Annexure P-6).

Heard.

In view of the statement made, the Court is not inclined to issue notice of motion, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Director, Department of Health & Family Welfare, Sector-34, Chandigarh to consider

and decide the decide the representation dated 14.02.2013 (Annexure P-6).
In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of three months thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
