This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of certiorari for quashing of the order dated 22.12.2016 (Annexure P-12) and in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent Corporation to grant the petitioners the pay-scale of post of Sub-Divisional Engineer; decide the representation filed by the petitioners (Annexure P-13).

Contentends that case of the petitioners is squarely covered by Annexure P-14 i.e. letter regarding sanction to grant regular pay scales to the employees of Punjab Health Systems Corporation.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Sudeepti Sharma, Addl.AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete copy

of the paper book has been furnished to the learned State counsel, in the Court.

In the circumstances, without adverting to the merits of the case, the respondent is directed to consider the case of the petitioners and decide whether case of the petitioners falls within the parameters laid down in Annexure P-14. In case answer is in affirmative, the necessary consequential relief be granted to the petitioners within eight weeks thereafter. In case, the competitive authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not made out, then a speaking order be passed in this regard.
