This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant extension of two years of service to the petitioner who being a disable persons, in terms of the policy.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that case of the petitioner is covered by notification dated 19.11.2014 (Annexure P-2). He further states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Chief Accounts Officer (Finance), Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd, The Mall, Tehsil and District Patiala to consider and decide the representation dated 17.01.2018 (Annexure P-4) in the light of Annexure P-2 prior to the date of superannuation of the petitioner which is stated to be on 30.06.2018.

Heard.

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the

case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Chief Accounts Officer (Finance), Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd, The Mall, Tehsil and District Patiala to consider and decide the representation dated 17.01.2018 (Annexure P-4) in the light of Annexure P-2 prior to the date of superannuation of the petitioner. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
