Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release the gratuity amount of Rs.4,77,799/- pending with respondent-department since 31.08.2015 without any reason WITH FURTHER directing the respondents to decide his representation dated 18.05.2017 (P-4) within stipulated period.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide the aforesaid representation (P-4), within some specified period.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into

the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the representation dated 18.05.2017 (P-4) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
