Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the husband of the petitioner had filed a writ petition in this Court seeking regularization of his services. However, during the pendency of the said writ petition, he died. Another co-petitioner, namely, Santosh Kumar also died and his wife was granted appointment on compassionate ground and subsequently her services were regularized. The petitioner was also granted appointment on compassionate grounds but her services have now been terminated w.e.f. 3.4.2018 although she was demanding parity in treatment with the wife of the co-petitioner mentioned hereinbefore. A representation dated 13.4.2018 (Annexure P-5) has been submitted but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Gaurav Jindal, Addl.A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Let four copies of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of order being passed, no written statement is necessary to be filed.

The writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider and decide the representation dated 13.04.2018 (Annexure P-5) after giving an opportunity of personal hearing to the petitioner and pass a speaking order thereupon within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
