By way of the present petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the respondents to adjust the petitioner in any Municipal Corporation/Municipal Council Improvement Trust on the post of clerk/inspectors lying vacant as per the recommendations of respondent No.3 dated 08.07.2014 (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel states that at this stage he would be satisfied in case the respondent No.1-Secretary, Department of Local Bodies, Punjab, Punjab Civil Secretariat-I, Chandigarh is directed to consider and decide the legal notice dated 29.03.2018 (Annexure P-5) in a time bound manner.

Heard.

In view of the above, without advertting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1-Secretary, Department of Local Bodies, Punjab, Punjab Civil

Secretariat-I, Chanidgarh to consider and decide the legal notice dated 29.03.2018 (Annexure P-5) in terms of recommendations dated 08.07.2014 (Annexure P-2) within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
