The claim of the petitioners for allotment of plots under the 'Oustees Category' was rejected by the Estate Officer-I, HUDA, Gurugram vide order dated 23.06.2014 on the plea that they did not submit the applications on time in response to the public notice dated 06.10.2013. The petitioners thereafter are said to have submitted representations on 04.07.2014 and 09.08.2017 claiming that the applications were actually submitted on time.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and in the light of categoric stand taken by them, coupled with the fact that residential houses of the petitioners are said to have been acquired and the same are likely to be demolished, the writ petition is disposed of without expressing any views on merits, with a direction to the Estate Officer-I, HUDA, Gurugram to re-verify the claim of the petitioners and pass appropriate orders within a period of three months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
