By way of the present petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of order dated 07.06.2016 (Annexure P-1), issued by respondent No.2 vide which respondent Nos.4 to 10 who are juniors to the petitioner have been promoted as Naib Tehsildar in their own pay scale.

Learned counsel states that at this stage he would be satisfied in case the respondent No.3-The Commissioner, Patiala Zone, Patiala is directed to consider and decide the legal notice dated 26.03.2018 (Annexure P-3) in a time bound manner.

Heard.

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-The Commissioner, Patiala Zone, Patiala to consider and decide the legal notice dated 26.03.2018 (Annexure P-3) within a period of six

weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
