By way of the present petition, the petitioners seek issuance of directions to the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioners for appointment in the Home Guard Department especially in view of the fact that the petitioners were removed illegally.

Learned counsel states that at this stage he would be satisfied in case respondent No.2-Director General of Police, Punjab, Punjab Police Headquarters, Sector-9, Chandigarh is directed to consider and decide the legal notice dated 20.03.2018 (Annexure P-4) pertaining to petitioner Nos.1 to 3 and legal notice dated 23.04.2018 (Annexure P-5) pertaining to petitioner Nos.4 to 13 in the light of judgment passed by this Court in CWP-13141-2018 titled as **Kulwant Singh and another Vs. State of Punjab and others**, decided on 23.05.2018 (Annexure P-7).

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the

case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Director General of Police, Punjab, Punjab Police Headquarters, Sector-9, Chandigarh to consider and decide the legal notice dated 20.03.2018 (Annexure P-4) pertaining to petitioner Nos.1 to 3 and legal notice dated 23.04.2018 (Annexure P-5) pertaining to petitioner Nos.4 to 13 in the light of assertion made within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. If, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the case of the petitioners is at par with the petitioners in the above said judgment, the competent authority is directed to pass the consequential order within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
