1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India by way of Public Interest Litigation for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to preserve the Panchayati Land and to maintain the same as per factual entries recorded in the record of right.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to approach the concerned authorities.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him in accordance with law.
