The petitioner is working as a Sweeper in a Government School. Her grievance is that she has been regularized with effect from a date which is later than the date from which her juniors have been regularized. Legal notice dated 16.01.2018 (Annexure P-6) has been issued in this regard but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only.

Mr. Hitesh Pandit, Addl. A.G. Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No. 1 to 3. Let four copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to issue notice to respondent No. 4 at this stage, neither it is necessary to seek written statement.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 3, to objectively consider the legal notice dated 16.01.2018(Annexure P-6) and pass a speaking order thereupon, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
