Learned counsel for the State submitted that prayer made in the present petition has been rendered infructuous as the impugned notification dated 21.3.2016 has been amended vide notification dated 19.12.2017 (Annexure R-1) attached with the written statement dated 6.2.2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that to that extent the prayer made in the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous, however, the petitioners should not be penalized for violation of notification dated 21.3.2016.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Rameshwar Birthal, Project Officer, Renewable Energy Department, Haryana, submitted that neither the penalty has been levied nor will be levied under the 2016 notification.

In view of the aforesaid stand taken by learned counsel for the parties, the writ petition stands disposed of.
