By way of the present petition, the petitioners seek issuance of directions to the respondents to grant the same pay scales of Rs.5000-8100 w.e.f. 01.01.1996 as revised from time to time and is being paid and granted to the similar employees who were earlier appointed on the same pay scale as to the petitioners in the Local Body Department.

Learned counsel states, at this stage, he will be satisfied in case respondent No.4 is directed to consider and decide the legal notice dated 26.08.2016 (Annexure P-8).

Heard.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4-Municipal Corporation, Bathinda through its Commissioner, to consider and decide the legal notice dated 26.08.2016 (Annexure P-8). In case, on consideration, the competent

authority reaches to the conclusion that the petitioners deserve for the relief claimed, then the consequential relief be allowed to them, within a period of three months thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not made out, then a speaking order be passed in this regard.
