Challenge in this writ petition is to the order dated 26.02.2018 (Annexure P-6) passed by the Superintending Canal Officer, Bhakra Water Services Division, Circle Fatehabad-respondent No.2, whereby, the orders passed by the authorities below were upheld, wherein, Khata Nos.32 and 34 have been clubbed up and the petitioners are getting separate Khata No.33, which is the tail end and half time is spent in filling up the khal prior to the water actually reaches to the fields of the petitioners.

I have considered the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioners and with his assistance, have gone through the impugned order but do not find any illegality therein especially with reference to the site plan which is appended along with the petition as Annexure P-3 as the petitioners are admittedly at the tail end and get the remaining water after the end of the carve and therefore, time which is spent in filling up the khal is ultimately utilized and give result to the petitioners. No prejudice

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appears to have been caused to the petitioners in any manner with the clubbing up of the wari at Khata Nos. 32 and 34.

Finding no merit in the present writ petition, the same stands dismissed.
