None appeared for respondent-Maharishi Dayanand University, Rohtak (MDU), though served.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioners has pointed out to us an amendment made by Executive Council of the said University. He has submitted that by virtue of the said amendment there is possibility of deletion of double entry in the matter of promotion for Steno-Typist. The amendment has been made effective w.e.f. 29.06.2016. We have taken on record the photocopy of the said amendment/resolution which is marked as mark 'X' for identification.

We have ourselves seen the written statement filed by the Registrar, MDU since none appeared for the University. We find from the perusal thereof that indeed there is a mention about the factum of amendment being made as to delete the offending clause. That is mentioned on internal page 10 of the written statement of the University

in sub Para N of Para 3. Upon reading the same we are satisfied that what is stated by learned Senior Advocate for the petitioners is correct.

To sum up, the grievance made by the petitioners in the petition therefore stands redressed. Learned senior counsel for the petitioners in the above backdrop of the facts prays for withdrawal of this petition. We accept his prayer for withdrawal and dispose of the present writ petition as withdrawn with no order as to cost.
