1. The petitioner has approached this Court for seeking direction to respondent No.1 to release all the mortgaged properties as the Cash Credit Limit of respondent No.2 has been settled and the account was closed on 10.10.2016.

2. Mr.Gaurav Goyal, learned counsel appearing for respondent No.1, stated that he has received a telephonic message from Mr.Sunny Chawla, Branch Manager-respondent No.1, that the title deed and other relevant documents would be released to the petitioner within a week.

3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the writ petition has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.

4. Disposed of accordingly.
5. However, a liberty is granted to the petitioner to file an application for revival of the writ petition in case the aforesaid documents are not released to him.
