By way of the present petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents for stepping up and for notional pay fixation after grant of 2nd and 3rd ACP and pension revision and other retiral benefits of the petitioner at par with juniors along with interest @ 18% per annum from the date of his entitlement.

Learned counsel states that at this stage he would be satisfied in case the respondent No.3-Chief Administrator, Haryana State Agricultural Marketing Board, C-6, Sector-6, Panchkula is directed to consider and decide the legal notice dated 04.09.2017 (Annexure P-12) in a time bound manner.

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent

No.3-Chief Administrator, Haryana State Agricultural Marketing Board, C-6, Sector-6, Panchkula to consider and decide the legal notice dated 04.09.2017 (Annexure P-12) within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
