The prayer made in this writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for quashing the letters No.910 & 911, dated 19.12.2016 (appended as Annexures P-10 & P-11, respectively), issued by respondent No.2.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has produced a communication dated 06.03.2018 in Court today, which is addressed to the Secretary-cum-E.O., Market Committee, Bahadurgarh by the Chief Administrator, Haryana State Agricultural Marketing Board, Panchkula. A copy of the same has been endorsed to the petitioners vide Endst. No. LA-II-2018/11883-84, dated 06.03.2018, intimating that in compliance to the orders of the High Court dated 14th February, 2018, the representation dated 05th March, 2018, received from the petitioners i.e. the allottees of Plot No.92 and 97 was considered and it has been decided to allot them alternative sites from vacant Plot Nos. 71 to 82 through draw of lots, which will be held on 21.03.2018. The said communication is taken on record,

subject to all just exceptions.

3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners states that the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.
