The only prayer made before us is that Execution proceedings regarding clearing the passage of the village from encroachers is pending. Proceedings under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Land (Regulation) Act were determined by the competent authority and upheld in appeal as well but the encroachers have not been removed from the identified area.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, we are of the opinion that the instant petition can be disposed of without issuance of notice of motion to the other side. If the order of eviction has been upheld and there is no further impediment by way of a restraint order, the execution should be carried out expeditiously. We direct respondent no.2 -Assistant Collector, Grade I, Safidon where the proceedings are pending to conclude the execution proceedings as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a

period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
