The resolution for allotment in favour of the landless was passed in 2008 and 2009. It is not in dispute before us that the possession has been given to the beneficiaries but they are not parties before us.

Petitioners pray that they be given alternate lands. The material on record shows that all the stake holders were consulted but nobody had raised any grievance. Therefore, the petitioner is an obstructionist who has come to the Court ostensibly for an ulterior motive to obstruct the rights of the landless. Besides, the allotment seems to have been made long time back in year 2011. Therefore, we are not inclined to interfere. Hence, instant petition is hereby dismissed.
