The petitioners are retired employees of the Punjab Tourism Development Corporation Limited, Chandigarh. They are aggrieved by the action of the Corporation with regard to the multiple issues involving the disputes of pension, pensionary benefits etc. which has not been resolved despite passage of time. The petitioners have made a representation (Annexure P-4) which has not been decided so far.

Mr. Bal appearing for the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondents to consider and decide the aforesaid representation and the pending claims within a fixed time period.

The request is fair and reasonable.

A direction is issued to respondent No.4 to consider and decide

the representation (Annexure P-4) by passing a speaking order and after providing opportunity to the representatives of the numerous petitioners, who are well versed of the case.

With these directions the petition stands disposed of.
