64 Petitioners were engaged on Adhoc basis as Teachers with different Elementary and Secondary Schools of the Department of Education, Punjab and did not go on strike on 08.02.1978. Their services were subsequently regularized and they now stand retired on attaining the age of superannuation. They are claiming the benefits of one increment for not having gone on Mass strike on 08.02.1978 in the light of the Instructions dated 16.6.1978 after a delay of 40 years.

The writ petition appears to be highly belated and, therefore, suffers from the vice of delay and laches. Even the complete details of the service particulars of the petitioners have not been furnished in the writ petition, nor the relevant instructions attached.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioner prays
for permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file fresh one

with better particulars.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
