This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned letter dated 28.03.2018 (Annexure P-3) and letter dated 03.04.2018 (Annexure P-8) and for issuance of a writ of mandamus for directing the respondents to decide the representation dated 31.03.2018 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.1- Director, Technical Education and Industrial Training Punjab to consider and decide the representation dated 31.03.2018 (Annexure P-5) in a time bound manner.

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to

respondent No.1- Director, Technical Education and Industrial

Training Punjab to consider and decide the representation dated 31.03.2018 (Annexure P-5) within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to her, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to her, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
