SURYA KANT J. (Oral)

(1) The grievance of the petitioners in the instant writ petition is that against the non-renewal of licence as Commission Agents, they have filed statutory revision petitions on 18.05.2018 (P2) which are pending before the State Government. Since their business as Commission Agents has been stopped and revision petitions are still pending, the petitioners are before this Court.

(2) We have heard learned counsel for the parties.

(3) In view of the fact that the petitioners have availed alternative statutory remedy and their revision petitions are pending, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the learned revisional authority, namely, the Principal Secretary, Agriculture Department, Haryana to decide the revision petitions filed by the petitioners as early as possible and preferably within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

(4) Till such time, the petitioners may be allowed to work as Commission Agents as an *ad hoc* measure subject to such conditions as may be imposed by Market Committee, Ambala city.
