Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that even though the petitioner cleared the written as well as driving test, he was not called for interview on the ground that his driving licence was of the year 2015 and therefore, as on the date of application, he did not possess three years of experience. This is stated to be factually incorrect as the driving licence of the petitioner is of the year 2011.

The writ petition is disposed of with direction that the petitioner may approach respondent No.2-Commission within a period of seven days from today with an appropriate representation and requisite documents and the respondent-Commission shall pass a speaking order thereupon within two days thereafter.

In case the allegation of the petitioner is proved to be correct, then he shall also be interviewed and his name shall be included in the merit list to be prepared by respondent No.2-Commission.
