By way of the present petition, the petitioners seek issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the order dated 16.08.2017 (Annexure P-11), passed by respondent No.2 vide which respondent No.2 conveyed to the Addl. Chief Secretary, Govt., of Punjab that petitioner No.2 cannot be issued the certificate enabling him to get the benefit of 2% quota reserved for 'Wards of Police Personnel' for appointment of Male Constable (Driver), vide advertisement dated 15.10.2016 (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel states that at this stage he would be satisfied in case the respondent No.2-Director General of Police, Police Headquarter, Sector-9, Chandigarh is directed to consider and decide the legal notice dated 09.04.2018 (Annexure P-12) in a time bound manner.

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the

case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Director General of Police, Police Headquarter, Sector-9, Chandigarh to consider and decide the legal notice dated 09.04.2018 (Annexure P-12) within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioners is admissible to them, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to them, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
