The petitioner is challenging the order dated 28.04.2015 (Annexure P-38), whereby his request for withdrawal of resignation has been rejected by the Government of India. The said course has not been adopted by the petitioner and this Court is not inclined to exercise its jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.
