The only grievance raised in the petition is that in the appeal before the Commissioner, accompanied by an application for stay interim relief was declined without assigning any reason.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the interim order to protect his possession would be essential, otherwise the remedy of appeal would be rendered illusory.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and noticing the limited grievance raised before us, we deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant petition without issuance of notice of motion to the other side on account of the directions that we propose to pass.

The Commissioner would decide the appeal as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

Till the decision of the appeal the dispossession of the petitioners shall remain stayed.

Petition stands disposed of.
